Peer Mentor Qualifications

TVCC Peer Mentors may dedicate an average of 8-10 hours per week with the understanding that this may fluctuate depending on need.

Required Qualifications:

- Peer Mentors must be currently enrolled in at least six (6) credits per quarter
- Be able to commit to a full quarter as a TVCC Peer Mentor
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher to continue employment

Preferred Qualifications:

- Prior leadership and/or community service experience demonstrating skills in interpersonal communications
- Ability to relate with people of diverse cultural, social and education experience
- Bilingual in English and Spanish is a plus but not required for consideration
